What is the difference between a PTA and PTSA?

Students at Ferndale Middle (grades 7 & 8), Ferndale High (grades 9-12) and University High (grades 9-12) Schools are allowed to join the PTA as card-carrying, dues-paying members with voting privileges. Because students can provide valuable ideas and manpower to the association, the PTA invites students to fully participate. This also provides a great opportunity for students to interact in a community organization. Since the PTSA designation was authorized by the National PTA in 1958, the proposed name of the association includes the PTSA label to reflect student participation.
